La Copa de Bobal, Covinas, ESP 2016

A cheeky little fruit bomb from Spain. Soft tannins but filled to the brim with fruit. happy to be drunk slightly cold, should you wish to have with fish.

Rosato Veronese IGT, Veritiere, ITA 2017
